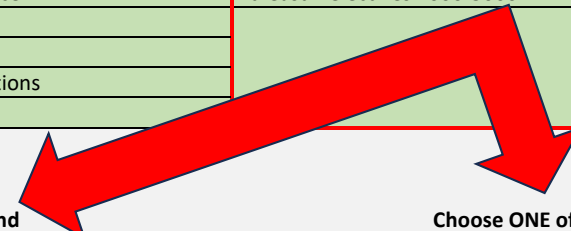


Suggested Finance Electives by Career Interest
