NOTATIONS FOR ALL STUDENTS:

- ACCT 2210 is not required for students who intend to major in Accounting
- BUSI 2100 is not required for students who intend to major in Marketing
- All bolded courses are taught Fall, Spring, and Summer terms (exception: BUSI 2010 will not be taught summer 2013)
- Upper-level 'major' courses are restricted. Only students who have officially declared specific 4-year major programs in the are eligible to take upper-level 'major' business course work.

TRANSFER STUDENTS:

- There are no transfer equivalents to BUSI 1010 or BUSI 2010. Those courses must be completed at Auburn.
- What if I am entering the College of Business as a junior, already know the specific major program I plan to pursue, and have completed all Pre-Business course work listed above *except BUSI 1010 and 2010*?

Regardless of classification upon transfer, BUSI 1010 and 2010 must also be completed before anything other than Pre-Business can be declared. There are a few junior-level business courses that Pre-Business students can take while they are completing the courses listed in blue font. Those courses are: ACCT 3110, ACCT 3310, AVMG 3050, **BUAL 3600**, ENFB 4140, **FINC 3610**, HRMN 3420, ISMN 3070, **MNGT 3100**, **MKTG 3310**, SCMN 3150, SCMN 3710, and any AVMF course. The courses listed in **red** font are required for all College of Business majors.

Choices for University Core Requirements

Students enrolled in the University Honors College may enroll in the Honors equivalents to the core options listed below.

(Reminder: If choosing the “two Literatures, one History” option of the Humanities/Social Sciences requirements, the two Lit courses must be a series. i.e. Students cannot mix and match 2 literatures from 2 differing series.)
