- **SCMH 1010 cannot pair with BIOL 1000/1001 -or- BIOL 1020/1021.**
- **BIOL 1000/1001 cannot pair with BIOL 1020/1021.**

## Approved core science pairings for students who have earned credit for one core science through AP, IB, dual enrollment, or transfer coursework

- **= BIOL 1020/1021 should be paired with BIOL 1010/1011**
- **= BIOL 1000/1001 should be paired with BIOL 1010/1011**

- = **Core BIOL I** should be paired with **BIOL 1010/1011**
  - = **CHEM 1010/1011** should be paired with **CHEM 1020/21** or **SCMH 1010**
  - = **CHEM 1030/1031** should be paired with **SCMH 1010**

  - = **GEOG 1020** should be paired with **GEOG 1030, GEOL 1100, or SCM H 1010**
